# Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 4 Days C

Day	Activities
1	<b>Charles Darwin Research Station:</b> Upon arriving to Baltra Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, the first visit of the trip will be to Charles Darwin Research Station where you will learn about the protection and conservation of the island, and visit the Breeding and Rearing Centre for young tortoises and adult Galapagos tortoises in captivity. After this activity, head back to the yacht for dinner.
2	<b>Mosquera Islet, and North Seymour Island:</b> After breakfast, the yacht will take you to Mosquera Islet, home to a group of sea lions, and that is also a place to observe shorebirds, herons, lava gulls and boobies. You can also practice snorkeling or diving here. In the afternoon, after lunch, the yacht will take you to North Seymour, an important spot to see frigate birds and blue-footed boobies courting the females. After this activity you will head back to the yacht for dinner..
3	<b>South Plaza and Santa Fe Island:</b> First activity of the day will be landing on Santa Fe Island, which is a great place to deep snorkel and swim along sea lions. This place is also the home of endemic species like the Galapagos Hawk, Galapagos snake and a variety of finches. In the afternoon, after lunch, you will head to South Plaza Island where you will see various species of land iguanas, marine iguanas and hybrids of this species. After this activity, dinner will be served onboard.
4	<b>Kicker Rock and Cerro Colorado Tortoise Reserve:</b> Early in the morning, you will take a dinghy ride around Kicker Rock or Leon Dormido, that is an ancient and eroded volcanic tuff, that serves as home to many species, such as birds, sea lions, and Nazca boobies. Then you will visit La Galapaguera breeding center, created to restore the populations of the threatened tortoise species. After this activity you will be transferred to Baltra Airport and take your flight back to the continent.
