Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 8 Days A+B

Day	Activities
1	Charles Darwin Research Station: Upon arriving to Baltra Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, the first visit of the trip will be to Charles Darwin Research Station where you will learn about the protection and conservation of the island, and visit the Breeding and Rearing Centre for young tortoises and adult Galapagos tortoises in captivity. After this activity, head back to the yacht for dinner.
2	Dragon Hill and Bartolome Island: Early in the morning, you will head to Dragon Hill at Santa Cruz Island, and walk through a trail that leads to a hyper-saline lagoon, that is frequently visited by flamingos, pintail ducks and other species of birds. After lunch, you will visit Bartolome Island, famous for its Pinnacle rock and its beautiful landscapes where you can take amazing pictures. You can also practice snorkel at this island. End of the activities and dinner onboard.
3	Rabida Island and Espumilla beach: Early start after landing at Rabida Island, where a red sand beach waits for you. You will take an excursion through a short trail to a water lagoon, home to wading flamingos. You will also visit a Palo Santo Forest. After lunch, head to Espumilla Beach in James Bay, where you can see playful sea lions, fur seals and various species of seabirds. This is also a good place to snorkel. End of the activities and dinner onboard
4	Black Turtle Cove: Early breakfast, and the day begins with a dinghy ride through Black Turtle Cove, where you can find 4 species of mangrove, and where you will spot turtles, herons, sharks and rays. After lunch, a bus will transfer you to the Highlands of Santa Cruz, where you will see Galapagos Giant Tortoises in its natural habitat. After this activity head back to the yacht for dinner.

Day	Activities
5	<p>Espinoza Point and Vicente Roca Point: First activity of the day will be heading to Vicente Roca Point, a wonderful snorkeling site, where you can see turtles and various species of fish. After lunch, head to Espinoza Point at Fernandina Island, that is one of the youngest islands with the most active volcano, and where you can spot pelicans, sea lions and marine iguanas. After this activity you will have dinner at the yacht and rest.</p>
6	<p>Tagus Cove and Urbina Bay: Early in the morning, you will visit Urbina Bay, one of the recent examples of geological uplift in the Galapagos, and it's also a seasonal nesting area for many tortoises and Galapagos Penguins, flightless cormorants and brown pelicans. During the afternoon, you will head to Tagus Cove in Isabela Island, that used to be a hide-out and deep-water anchorage in the days of the pirates. Here you will go for a hike to the top of a cliff to view the volcanic landscapes of Darwin Volcano and Darwin Lake. After these activities head back to the yacht for dinner.</p>
7	<p>Port Egas and Sullivan Bay First activity of the day will be wet landing at James Bay also known as Port Egas, where an easy walk will take you to observe iguanas and sea lions in the coast line. You can also swim or snorkel here. During the afternoon, the yacht will land in Sullivan Bay at Santiago Island where you can witness the rope lava flows, and sea lions that rest through the shore. You can also practice shallow water snorkeling here. After his activities head back to the yacht for dinner.</p>
8	<p>Bachas Beach: Early in the morning, head to Bachas Beach, with a lagoon behind the high tide line, where you can watch marine iguanas and flamingoes, and is also a nesting area for green sea turtles form November to February. After this activity, you will be transferred to Baltra Airport and take your flight back to the continent.</p>
