# Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 8 Days B+C

Day	Activities
1	<b>Santa Cruz Highlands:</b> Upon arriving to Baltra Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, a bus will transfer you to the Highlands of Santa Cruz, where you will see Galapagos Giant Tortoises in their natural habitat. After this activity head back to the yacht for dinner.
2	<b>Espinoza Point and Vicente Roca Point:</b> First activity of the day will be heading to Vicente Roca Point, a wonderful snorkeling site, where you can see turtles and various species of fish. After lunch, head to Espinoza Point at Fernandina Island, that is one of the youngest islands with the most active volcano, and where you can spot pelicans, sea lions and marine iguanas. After this activity you will have dinner at the yacht and rest.
3	<b>Tagus Cove and Urbina Bay:</b> Early in the morning, you will visit Urbina Bay, one of the recent examples of geological uplift in the Galapagos, and it's also a seasonal nesting area for many tortoises and Galapagos Penguins, flightless cormorants and brown pelicans. During the afternoon, you will head to Tagus Cove in Isabela Island, that used to be a hide-out and deep-water anchorage in the days of the pirates. Here you will go for a hike to the top of a cliff to view the volcanic landscapes of Darwin Volcano and Darwin Lake. After these activities head back to the yacht for dinner.
4	<b>Port Egas and Rabida:</b> First activity of the day will be wet landing at James Bay also known as Port Egas, where an easy walk will take you to observe iguanas and sea lions in the coast line. You can also swim or snorkel here. During the afternoon, the yacht will land in Sullivan Bay at Santiago Island where you can witness the rope lava flows, and sea lions that rest through the shore. You can also practice shallow water snorkeling here. After his activities head back to the yacht for dinner.

Day	Activities
5	<b>Bachas Beach and Charles Darwin Research Station:</b> Early in the morning, head to Bachas Beach, with a lagoon behind the high tide line, where you can watch marine iguanas and flamingoes, and is also a nesting area for green sea turtles from November to February. After this activity, you will visit Charles Darwin Research Station where you will learn about the protection and conservation of the island, and visit the Breeding and Rearing Centre for young tortoises and adult Galapagos tortoises in captivity. After this activity, head back to the yacht for dinner.
6	<b>Mosquera Islet, and North Seymour Island:</b> After breakfast, the yacht will take you to Mosquera Islet, home to a group of sea lions, and that is also a place to observe shorebirds, herons, lava gulls and boobies. You can also practice snorkeling or diving here. In the afternoon, after lunch, the yacht will take you to North Seymour, an important spot to see frigate birds and blue-footed boobies courting the females. After this activity you will head back to the yacht for dinner.
7	<b>South Plaza and Santa Fe Island:</b> First activity of the day will be landing on Santa Fe Island, which is a great place to snorkel and swim along sea lions. This place is also the home of endemic species like the Galapagos Hawk, Galapagos snake and a variety of finches. In the afternoon, after lunch, you will head to South Plaza Island where you will see various species of land iguanas, marine iguanas and hybrids of this species. After this activity, dinner will be served onboard.
8	<b>Kicker Rock and Cerro Colorado Tortoise Reserve:</b> Early in the morning, the yacht will take you for a ride around Kicker Rock or Leon Dormido, that is an ancient and eroded volcanic tuff, that serves as home to many species, such as birds, sea lions, and Nazca boobies. Then you will visit La Galapaguera breeding center, created to restore the populations of the threatened tortoise species. After this activity you will be transferred to Baltra Airport and take your flight back to the continent.



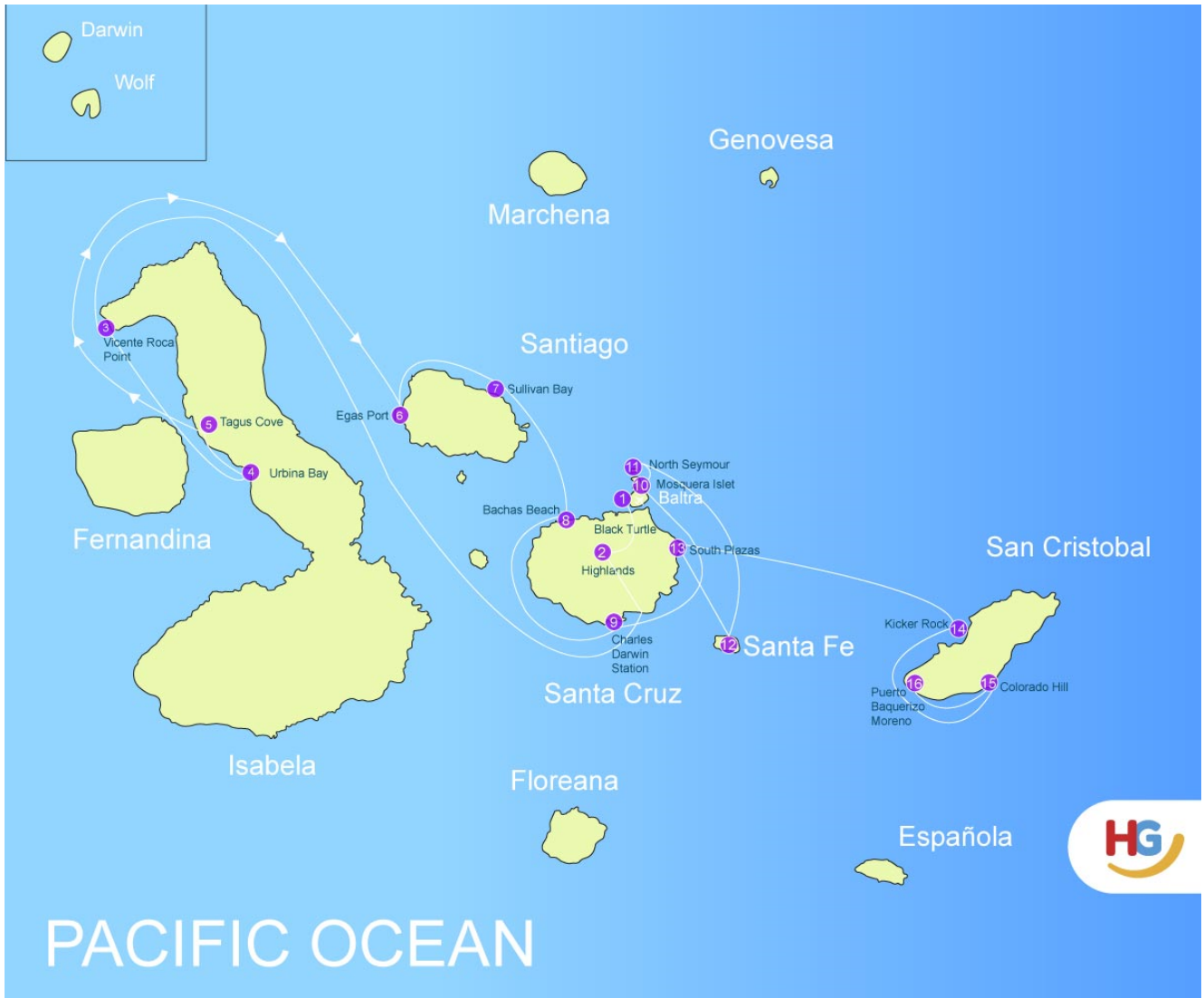
