Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 8 Days C+D

Day	Activities
1	Charles Darwin Research Station: Upon arriving to Baltra Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, the first visit of the trip will be to Charles Darwin Research Station where you will learn about the protection and conservation of the island, and visit the Breeding and Rearing Centre for young tortoises and adult Galapagos tortoises in captivity. After this activity, head back to the yacht for dinner.
2	Mosquera Islet, and North Seymour Island: After breakfast, the yacht will take you to Mosquera Islet, home to a group of sea lions, and that is also a place to observe shorebirds, herons, lava gulls and boobies. You can also practice snorkeling or diving here. In the afternoon, after lunch, the yacht will take you to North Seymour, an important spot to see frigate birds and blue-footed boobies courting the females. After this activity you will head back to the yacht for dinner.
3	South Plaza and Santa Fe Island: First activity of the day will be landing on Santa Fe Island, which is a great place to snorkel and swim along sea lions. This place is also the home of endemic species like the Galapagos Hawk, Galapagos snake and a variety of finches. In the afternoon, after lunch, you will head to South Plaza Island where you will see various species of land iguanas, marine iguanas and hybrids of this species. After this activity, dinner will be served onboard.
4	San Cristobal Island: Early in the morning, the yacht will land at San Cristobal Island, and your first visit will be to Cerro Colorado Tortoises Protection and Growing Centre, where you will see different species of native and endemic plants. You will be able to discover the amazing and emblematic Galapagos Tortoises. After lunch, you will head to San Cristobal Interpretation Center, where you will learn about the colonization of the Islands, their Natural History and conservation efforts that have been made to preserve the species. After this activity, return to the yacht for dinner

Day	Activities
5	<p>Cerro Brujo and Pitt Point: Early in the morning, the first visit will be to Cerro Brujo (Sorcerer's Hill'), where you can enjoy sharing the beach with sea lions, snorkeling from the shore or take a walk to a lagoon to see native bird species. After lunch, the yacht will take you to Pitt Point, where you will go to a brief hike to the steep eroded tuff cone, and you will enjoy the views and also see various species of boobies that nest there. After this visit, return to the yacht for dinner.</p>
6	<p>Suarez Point and Gardner Bay: Early in the morning head to head to Suarez Point on Española Island, that is a basaltic cliff which forms a blowhole where water sprays high into the air. A hike to the top makes a great opportunity to take spectacular pictures. You can also watch sea lions, sea birds, Marine Iguanas, masked and blue footed boobies, among others. In the afternoon, the yacht will take you to Gardner Bay, which will be a great opportunity for snorkeling and swim.</p>
7	<p>Floreana Island: Early in the morning, head to Floreana Island, your first stop will be Cormorant Point, where you will be welcomed by a small Galapagos sea lion colony. You will also visit green sand beach that contains olivine crystal, and a white coral sand beach. You can also practice deep water snorkeling at Devil's Crown, home to an abundance of fish and marine animals. After lunch, the yacht will take you to Post Office bay, that was established in 1793 by British whalers to send letters to and from England, and even today, visitors have the opportunity to send letters of their own. End of the day and dinner.</p>
8	<p>Santa Cruz Highlands: Early in the morning you will visit the Highlands of Santa Cruz, where you will see Galapagos Giant Tortoises in its natural habitat at El Chato Reserve. After this visit, you will be transferred to Baltra Airport and take your flight back to the continent.</p>
