# Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 8 Days D+A

Day	Activities
1	<b>San Cristobal Interpretation Center:</b> Upon arriving to San Cristobal Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, the first visit will be to San Cristobal Interpretation Center, where you will learn about the colonization of the Islands, their Natural History and conservation efforts that have been made to preserve the species. Then, you will head to Tijeretas Hill, where you will be able to see a species of frigates named "Tijeretas" hence the name of this place. After this activity, return to the yacht for dinner.
2	<b>Cerro Brujo and Pitt Point:</b> Early in the morning, the first visit will be to Cerro Brujo (Sorcerer's Hill'), where you can enjoy sharing the beach with sea lions, snorkeling from the shore or take a walk to a lagoon to see native bird species. After lunch, the yacht will take you to Pitt Point, where you will go to a brief hike to the steep eroded tuff cone, and you will enjoy the views and also see various species of boobies that nest there. After this visit, return to the yacht for dinner.
3	<b>Suarez Point and Gardner Bay:</b> Early in the morning head to head to Suarez Point on Española Island, that is a basaltic cliff which forms a blowhole where water sprays high into the air. A hike to the top makes a great opportunity to take spectacular pictures. You can also watch sea lions, sea birds, Marine Iguanas, masked and blue footed boobies, among others. In the afternoon, the yacht will take you to Gardner Bay, which will be a great opportunity for snorkeling and swim.
4	<b>Floreana Island:</b> Early in the morning, head to Floreana Island, your first stop will be Cormorant Point, where you will be welcomed by a small Galapagos sea lion colony. You will also visit green sand beach that contains olivine crystal, and a white coral sand beach. You can also practice deep water snorkeling at Devil's Crown, home to an abundance of fish and marine animals. After lunch, the yacht will take you to Post Office bay, that was established in 1793 by British whalers to send letters to and from England, and even today, visitors have the opportunity to send letters of their own. End of the day and dinner.



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5	<b>Santa Cruz Highlands:</b> Early in the morning you will visit the Highlands of Santa Cruz, where you will see Galapagos Giant Tortoises in its natural habitat at El Chato Reserve. After this visit, you will be transferred to Charles Darwin Research Station where you will learn about the protection and conservation of the island, and visit the Breeding and Rearing Centre for young tortoises and adult Galapagos tortoises in captivity. After this activity, head back to the yacht for dinner.
6	<b>Dragon Hill and Bartolome Island:</b> Early in the morning, you will head to Dragon Hill at Santa Cruz Island, and walk through a trail that leads to a hyper-saline lagoon, that is frequently visited by flamingos, pintail ducks and other species of birds. After lunch, you will visit Bartolome Island, famous for its Pinnacle rock and its beautiful landscapes where you can take amazing pictures. You can also practice snorkel at this island. End of the activities and dinner onboard.
7	<b>Rabida Island and Espumilla beach:</b> Early start after landing at Rabida Island, where a red sand beach waits for you. You will take an excursion through a short trail to a water lagoon, home to wading flamingos. You will also visit a Palo Santo Forest. After lunch, head to Espumilla Beach in James Bay, where you can see playful sea lions, fur seals and various species of seabirds. This is also a good place to snorkel. End of the activities and dinner onboard.
8	<b>Black Turtle Cove:</b> Early breakfast, and the day begins with a dinghy ride through Black Turtle Cove, where you can find 4 species of mangrove, and where you will spot turtles, herons, sharks and rays. After this activity you will be transferred to Baltra's airport, to take your flight back to the continent.
