6	<p><b>Tortoise Breeding Center and Flamingo Pool:</b> You can enjoy a free morning before taking the speedboat to Isabela at 2pm. A trip to Las Grietas makes for a fun morning activity; it is literally a crack between large lava rocks, with water in between of an unbelievable color! A great spot for swimming or snorkeling. The 20-minute walk to Las Grietas is also very pleasant. If you don't feel like more activity, you can go for a relaxing walk along the promenade in Puerto Ayora, do more souvenir shopping, people &amp; animal watch at the morning fish-market, or visit the peaceful Las Ninfas lake. Upon arrival to Puerto Villamil on Isabela Island you'll be met by your guide and transferred to your hotel. A little later your guide will walk you up the beach, and to the Isabela tortoise breeding center, where you get to see these various sub-species of giant tortoises up close, from tiny babies to fully grown adults, and can learn about the breeding program and incubation process. If you still have energy, you can continue the walk to a lagoon where you have the chance to see Galapagos Flamingos (endemic subspecies) and other wading birds.</p>	B	ESG
7	<p><b>Los Tuneles snorkeling tour:</b> Free afternoon: Today's tour takes you to Los Tuneles by boat, this is a fascinating landscape of huge lava tunnels. You begin on land where Blue Footed Boobies often nest, and afterwards can enjoy snorkeling at one of the very best snorkel sites at Galapagos! White Tipped Reef Sharks, Marine Turtles, Sting Rays, Sea Lions, Eagle Rays and even Sea Horses are regularly seen here!</p> <p>In the afternoon you have free time to explore Isabela's treasures on your own. If you want to do more snorkeling, the Concha Perla is close to town and a beautiful spot for snorkeling close to the mangrove trees in clear waters, or head down to the port where penguins and sea lions can often be seen swimming. You also have a stunning white sand beach at your disposal, for relaxation or a nice stroll.</p>	B/S	ESG
8	<p><b>Tintoreras Islet:</b> In the morning you will visit Las Tintoreras and the Bay area. This trip combines three interesting activities: 1. Panga ride = cruising around the bay by boat, observing wildlife such as Blue Footed Boobies, Galapagos Penguins (depending on the season), Galapagos Sea Lions, Pacific Green Sea Turtles, amongst others. 2. Guided trail hike = a 45 min trek around the islet, passing close to a huge Marine Iguana colony, as well as Galapagos Sea Lions, Sally Lightfoot Crabs, White-Tip Reef Sharks and more. 3. Snorkeling = in the bay area, hopefully accompanied by Pacific Green Sea Turtles, Galapagos Sea Lions, White-Tip Reef Sharks, as well as a variety of rays (Spotted Eagle Rays, Diamond Stingrays, Golden Rays). In the afternoon you have time to explore the island on your own. We recommend a bike ride to the Wall of Tears – a 100m long wall of tragic historical significance, built by Ecuadorian prisoners during the 1940s and 50s, many of whom dies during the construction of the wall due to the awful conditions in which they were forced to work.</p>	B	ESG
